For 40 years, Salt Creek Ballet is a leading 501(c)3 not-for-profit Chicagoland ballet school and performance company dedicated to dance education, while providing high-level performance opportunities for our dancers, founded upon the discipline and artistry of classical ballet.

Salt Creek Ballet's high standards and unique blend of major classical productions and artistically diverse and challenging repertory programs have brought critical acclaim, sold-out performances, and a loyal following. Internationally known guest artists, choreographers, and designers regularly work with Salt Creek Ballet to provide dancers and audiences alike with a level of performance usually associated with professional companies.

At the heart of our ethos, we not only encourage appreciation and awareness of dance but believe dance education is of the highest priority. This philosophy drives our dedication to nurturing our dancers with the disciplines and life skills that dance teaches, which encourages them to reach their greatest potential in and out of the studio, no matter what life path they take.



Our critically acclaimed performances can be seen beginning Thanksgiving weekend at three venues; Hinsdale Central High School, North Shore Center for the Performing Arts, and McAninch Arts Center at the College of DuPage. Through these performances, our SCB dancers bring the magic of *The Nutcracker* to audiences of thousands.

The Nutcracker is exquisitely performed by Salt Creek Ballet Company Dancers and students, dancing side-by-side with Internationally known guest artists, representing prestigious companies such as Joffrey Ballet, American Ballet Theatre, and New York Ballet to name a few.

MEET OUR DIRECTORS



Erica De La O, ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

Erica De La O, from East Los Angeles, CA, has had a distinguished career in classical ballet, performing principal roles in iconic productions like La Sylphide, Giselle, Swan Lake, Romeo and Juliet, Cinderella, Coppelia, Don Quixote, Sleeping Beauty, Les Sylphides, and Lady of the Camellias. She also has performed leading roles in contemporary works by Balanchine, Paul Taylor, Twyla Tharp, Stephen Baynes, Adam Hougland, Lucas Jervies, Val Caniparoli, Ben Stevenson, Harrison McEldowney, Helen Pickett, Ma Cong, and many others. Her honors include the Sono Osato Award, the John Orr Award from the Pasadena Arts Council, Kentucky Women Foundation, a fellowship from Hadley Creatives, and a silver medal at the Los Angeles' Music Center Spotlight Awards. Erica created Bunhead Talks, an educational vehicle to examine dance through the anthropological lens, and parent/student dance education. Erica holds an MFA from Hollins University. She earned an EMBA from the University of Louisville and University of Kentucky Schools of Business. Salt Creek Ballet, under the Artistic Direction of Erica De La O and her husband Kristopher Wojtera, has created family-friendly ballet series: Swan Lake 2023 and Don Quixote 2024, further solidifying Erica's impact on the ballet community as both an artist and a visionary leader.



Kristopher Wojtera, ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

Kristopher Wojtera, born in Poland, embarked on his ballet journey at the National Ballet School in Gdansk at age ten. Over 28 years, he flourished as a Principal artist, portraying leading roles in classical and contemporary ballets, and collaborating with renowned choreographers worldwide. His career spanned engagements with prestigious companies like Polish National Theatre, English National Ballet, and Louisville Ballet. While actively performing, he pursued further education, obtaining a Master of Fine Arts in Dance from Hollins University and Vaganova Teaching certifications. Recognized for his talent and dedication, he received awards including the Carolina New House Scholarship and the Sono Osato Award. Now serving as Artistic Director, he brings a wealth of experience to Salt Creek Ballet, where he will share his expertise through teaching, coaching, and shaping the company's artistic vision. Wojtera eagerly anticipates contributing to the advancement of Salt Creek Ballet's mission.





COMMUNITY OUTREACH

DANCE EXPLORERS







Launched in the Spring of 2022, Our Dance Explorers Program at Salt Creek Ballet is tailored for children from Pre-K to 3rd grade and serves as a delightful and fun entry into the vibrant world of dance.

This initiative invites young ones to our studios, where they discover and experience a variety of different dance styles at the beginner level. Designed not only to foster a love for dance, **Dance Explorers** classes are designed to enhance sensory-motor skills and cognitive abilities by immersing children in the joyful and creative exploration of movement through dance.

Dance Explorers includes children from low-income households, minorities, and individuals with disabilities who would otherwise not be exposed to dance and its benefits.

LITERACY THROUGH DANCE





Our Literacy Through Dance program combines the beauty of literature with the expressiveness of movement, creating a dynamic and enriching experience for early elementary school children.

We go into the schools and bring fairy tales to life with ballet and classical music within their very own classrooms, exposing students to a multi-week immersion in the arts.

The program extends beyond the classroom with opportunities for students to visit the Salt Creek Ballet Studios in Westmont and enjoy complimentary attendance at our annual showcases, including the beloved Nutcracker performances.

Why is this important?

New research has found a strong memory link for concepts when language is paired with movement, making this program an innovative approach to learning.

The profound impact on our students is measured both in numbers and narratives, through rigorous pre and post-program vocabulary testing, and careful observation of student involvement and reaction.

How we make it happen:

We partner with Westmont School Districts ASD4 and D201. Our programs are designed to be versatile and effective.

Each grade level is tailored to fit the unique academic, social-emotional, and physical needs of each school environment.

LIBRARY PROGRAMS

We bring literature to life through music and dance!

Children learn dance movements based on characters from a selected theme/book and perform for their parents.





LECTURE SERIES AND DEMONSTRATIONS



Targeted toward the retirement community and other community groups, our visiting artists, accompanied by our Salt Creek Ballet Company dancers dressed in beautifully made costumes, share insights into the production and artistic process of dance productions.

Lecture demonstrations run 45 minutes and can be tailored to fit the needs of your community group or retirement community.
